Some Groton historians of note were General *Albert Harleigh Hill*, grandson of Captain Edmund Morse, *Hosea Newell Welch*, great grandson of Jonathan Welch, and *Waldo F. Glover*, author of "Mister Glover's Groton" the chronicle of Groton, Vermont from 1789 to 1978, which was completed and published by Groton Historical Society after Mr. Glover's death in 1976.

Who remembers stories about the events in Groton during the last century?

The Groton Historical Society may become history unless volunteers can be recruited to help with ongoing and new projects to record and preserve the History of Groton and it's people.

The collection of photographs need to be organized, cataloged, and stored for easy retrieval before they get lost or damaged. 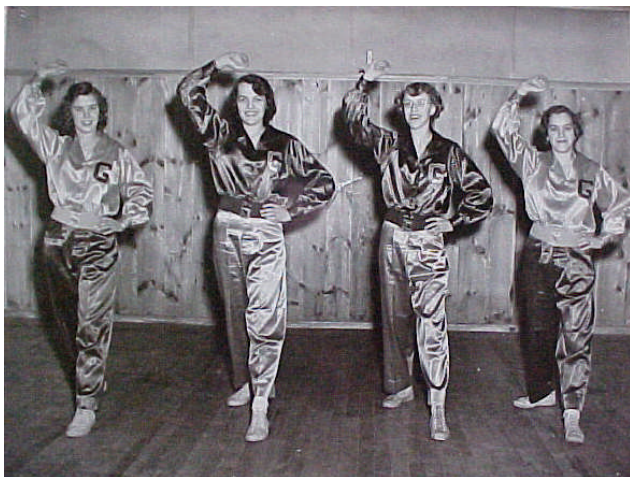
